A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to mandatory emergency alert systems at institutions of

- 3 higher education.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 51.218 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.218. EMERGENCY ALERT SYSTEM. (a) In this section,
- 8 "institution of higher education" and "private or independent
- 9 institution of higher education" have the meanings assigned by
- 10 Section 61.003.
- 11 (b) Each institution of higher education and private or
- 12 independent institution of higher education shall establish an
- 13 emergency alert system for the institution's students and staff,
- 14 including faculty. The emergency alert system must use e-mail or
- 15 telephone notifications in addition to any other alert method the
- 16 institution considers appropriate to provide timely notification
- 17 of emergencies affecting the institution or its students and staff.
- 18 <u>(c)</u> At the time a student initially enrolls or registers for
- 19 courses or a staff member begins employment, the institution shall:
- 20 <u>(1) obtain a personal telephone number or e-mail</u>
- 21 address from the student or staff member to be used to notify the
- 22 individual in the event of an emergency; and
- 23 (2) register the student or staff member in the
- 24 institution's emergency alert system.

- 1 (d) A student or staff member may elect not to participate
- 2 in an emergency alert system established under this section. An
- 3 election under this subsection may be submitted electronically or
- 4 in writing, as chosen by the institution, and must be renewed at the
- 5 start of each academic year.
- 6 (e) The personal identifying information obtained from an
- 7 individual for the purpose of the emergency alert system of an
- 8 institution of higher education, including an e-mail address or
- 9 telephone number, is confidential and not subject to disclosure
- 10 under Section 552.021, Government Code.
- 11 (f) Each institution of higher education and private or
- 12 independent institution of higher education shall implement the
- 13 emergency alert system required by this section not later than the
- 14 spring 2012 <u>semester</u>. This subsection expires June 1, 2012.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
