AN ACT

2 relating to an exemption for the denial of driver's license renewal 3 for violations of local ordinances concerning solid waste and heavy 4 trash.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 706.004, Transportation Code, is amended 7 to read as follows:

Sec. 706.004. DENIAL OF RENEWAL OF DRIVER'S LICENSE. 8 (a) If a political subdivision has contracted with the department, on 9 receiving the necessary information from the political subdivision 10 11 the department may deny the renewal of a person's driver's license 12 for failure to appear based on a complaint or citation or failure to pay or satisfy a judgment ordering the payment of a fine and cost in 13 14 the manner ordered by the court in a matter involving an offense described by Section 706.002(a). 15

(b) The information must include:

17 (1) the name, date of birth, and driver's license 18 number of the person;

(2) the nature and date of the alleged violation;

(3) a statement that the person failed to appear as
required by law or failed to satisfy a judgment ordering payment of
a fine and the cost in a matter involving an offense described by
Section 706.002(a); and

(4) any other information required by the department.
