H.B. No. 2763

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to an exemption for the denial of driver's license renewal
3 for violations of local ordinances concerning solid waste and heavy
4 trash.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 706.004, Transportation Code, is amended
7 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 706.004. DENIAL OF RENEWAL OF DRIVER'S LICENSE. (a)
9 If a political subdivision has contracted with the department, on
10 receiving the necessary information from the political subdivision
11 the department may deny the renewal of a person's driver's license
12 for failure to appear based on a complaint or citation or failure to
13 pay or satisfy a judgment ordering the payment of a fine and cost in
14 the manner ordered by the court in a matter involving an offense
15 described by Section 706.002(a).

16 (b) The information must include:

17 (1) the name, date of birth, and driver's license
18 number of the person;

19 (2) the nature and date of the alleged violation;

20 (3) a statement that the person failed to appear as
21 required by law or failed to satisfy a judgment ordering payment of
22 a fine and the cost in a matter involving an offense described by
23 Section 706.002(a); and

24 (4) any other information required by the department.

1 (c) The department shall not deny renewal of a driver's
2 license under this Section if the underlying offense described by
3 Section 706.002(a) is a violation of a local ordinance concerning
4 solid waste or heavy trash procedures.
