4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 545.309 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 545.309. PARKING CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT AND CERTAIN
8	VEHICLES; OFFENSE. (a) This section applies to:
9	(1) construction equipment; and
10	(2) a motor vehicle, other than a light truck or
11	passenger car, used in connection with a construction project.
12	(b) This section applies only to a highway with a posted
13	speed limit of more than 35 miles per hour.
14	(c) This section does not apply to residential construction
15	of a one or two family dwelling.
16	(d) A person commits an offense if:
17	(1) the person parks a motor vehicle or construction
18	equipment within 30 feet of the nearest edge of a roadway during a
19	period in which construction for which the equipment or vehicle is
20	normally used is not occurring in the adjacent area; and
21	(2) the person or a construction worker who normally
22	works on a construction project in the adjacent area for which the
23	equipment or vehicle is normally used is not physically present in
24	that area.

- 1 (e) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 2 (f) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (c)
- 3 <u>th</u>at:
- 4 (1) the person parked the vehicle or equipment at
- 5 <u>least 10 feet from the nearest edge of the roadway; and</u>
- 6 (2) a barricade separated the vehicle or equipment
- 7 from the nearest edge of the roadway.
- 8 (g) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (c)
- 9 that:
- 10 (1) the location made it impossible for the person to
- 11 comply with that subsection; and
- 12 (2) the person parked the vehicle or equipment in
- 13 <u>accordance</u> with the Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control
- 14 Devices.
