A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the purchasing powers and duties of a navigation
- 3 district or port authority.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 60.4035(a), Water Code, as amended by
- 6 Chapters 415 (H.B. 1972) and 1191 (H.B. 3785), Acts of the 81st
- 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is reenacted to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (a) Notwithstanding the competitive bidding requirements
- 10 and proposal procedures of this subchapter and Subchapter O and the
- 11 requirements of Sections 60.408(a), (b), (c), (d), and (e), the
- 12 executive director of a district or an officer of a district
- 13 authorized in writing by the port commission may make emergency
- 14 purchases or contracts or emergency amendments to existing purchase
- 15 orders or contracts in an amount that exceeds the amount authorized
- 16 under Section 60.403(a) for routine purchases or contracts if
- 17 necessary:
- 18 (1) to preserve or protect the public health and
- 19 safety of the residents of the district;
- 20 (2) to preserve the property of the district in the
- 21 case of a public calamity;
- 22 (3) to repair unforeseen damage to the property of the
- 23 district; or
- 24 (4) to respond to security directives issued by:

- 1 (A) the federal Department of Homeland Security,
- 2 including the Transportation Security Administration;
- 3 (B) the United States Coast Guard;
- 4 (C) the federal Department of Transportation,
- 5 including the Maritime Administration; or
- 6 (D) another federal or state agency responsible
- 7 for domestic security.
- 8 SECTION 2. Sections 60.404(a) and (d), Water Code, as
- 9 amended by Chapters 415 (H.B. 1972) and 1191 (H.B. 3785), Acts of
- 10 the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, are reenacted to read
- 11 as follows:
- 12 (a) If the materials, supplies, machinery, equipment, or
- 13 other items to be purchased or contracted for are valued at an
- 14 amount greater than the amount authorized under Section 60.403(a)
- 15 for routine purchases or contracts, notice shall be published as
- 16 provided by this section.
- 17 (d) The specifications must:
- 18 (1) describe in detail the item to be acquired;
- 19 (2) require that bids be sealed;
- 20 (3) require the attachment to the bid of a certified
- 21 check, cashier's check, or bidders bond, if security is required in
- 22 connection with the bid; and
- 23 (4) indicate whether a small business development
- 24 program adopted by the port commission of the port authority or
- 25 district applies to the purchase and, if so, where a copy of the
- 26 program requirements may be obtained.
- SECTION 3. Section 60.406(a), Water Code, as amended by

- 1 Chapters 415 (H.B. 1972) and 1191 (H.B. 3785), Acts of the 81st
- 2 Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is reenacted to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 (a) Except as otherwise provided by Section 60.4035 or
- 5 60.412, before a district or port authority may purchase one or more
- 6 items under a contract that will require an expenditure of more than
- 7 the amount authorized under Section 60.403(a) for routine purchases
- 8 or contracts, the port commission of that district or port
- 9 authority must comply with the competitive bidding requirements or
- 10 proposal procedures provided by this subchapter or Subchapter O.
- 11 All bids must be sealed.
- 12 SECTION 4. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 13 over another Act of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011,
- 14 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 15 codes.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
