## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the salary paid to certain professional employees of
- 3 public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsections (c-4) and
- 7 (c-5) to read as follows:
- 8 (c) The salary factors per step are as follows:
- 9 Years Experience 0 1 2 3 4
- 10 Salary Factor  $\underline{.6910}$  [ $\underline{.6226}$ ]  $\underline{.7044}$  [ $\underline{.6360}$ ]  $\underline{.7176}$  [ $\underline{.6492}$ ]  $\underline{.7311}$  [ $\underline{.6627}$ ]  $\underline{.7593}$  [ $\underline{.6999}$ ]

- 15 Years Experience 15 16 17 18 19
- 17 Years Experience 20 and over
- 18 Salary Factor <u>1.0773</u> [<del>1.009</del>]
- 19 <u>(c-4) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2011-2012</u>
- 20 school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
- 21 counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse
- 22 is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the sum of:
- 23 (1) the monthly salary the employee would have
- 24 received for the 2011-2012 school year under the district's salary

- 1 schedule for the 2010-2011 school year, if that schedule had been in
- 2 effect for the 2011-2012 school year, including any local
- 3 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement
- 4 the employee would have received in the 2011-2012 school year; and
- 5 (2) \$300.
- 6 (c-5) Subsection (c-4) and this subsection expire September
- 7 1, 2012.
- 8 (d) A classroom teacher, full-time speech pathologist,
- 9 full-time librarian, full-time counselor certified under
- 10 Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse employed by a school
- 11 district in the 2011-2012 [2010-2011] school year is, as long as the
- 12 employee is employed by the same district, entitled to a salary that
- 13 is at least equal to the salary the employee received for the
- 14 2011-2012 [<del>2010-2011</del>] school year.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 42.2516, Education Code, is amended by
- 16 adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 17 (e-1) The amount of state aid or credit to which a school
- 18 district is entitled under Section 42.25111 is in addition to the
- 19 amount of revenue to which the district is entitled under
- 20 Subsection (b).
- SECTION 3. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
- 22 amended by adding Section 42.25111 to read as follows:
- 23 <u>Sec. 42.25111.</u> <u>ADDITIONAL STATE AID OR CREDIT AGAINST COST</u>
- 24 OF ATTENDANCE CREDITS FOR PROFESSIONAL STAFF SALARIES. (a) A
- 25 school district, including a school district that is otherwise
- 26 <u>ineligible for state aid under this chapter</u>, is entitled to state
- 27 aid in an amount, as determined by the commissioner, equal to the

- 1 product of \$3,000 multiplied by the number of classroom teachers,
- 2 full-time librarians, full-time counselors certified under
- 3 Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time school nurses employed by
- 4 the district and entitled to a minimum salary under Section 21.402.
- 5 (b) A school district that is required to take action under
- 6 Chapter 41 to reduce its wealth per student to the equalized wealth
- 7 level is entitled to a credit, in the amount of state aid to which
- 8 the district is entitled under this section, against the total
- 9 amount required under Section 41.093 for the district to purchase
- 10 <u>attendance credits.</u>
- 11 (c) A determination by the commissioner under this section
- 12 <u>is final and may not be appealed.</u>
- (d) The commissioner may adopt rules to implement this
- 14 section.
- SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 16 school year.
- 17 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
