- 2 relating to the registration and compulsory inspection of certain
- 3 street rods and custom vehicles.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 501, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 501.038 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 501.038. CERTIFICATE OF TITLE FOR CUSTOM VEHICLE OR
- 8 STREET ROD. (a) In this section, "custom vehicle" and "street rod"
- 9 have the meanings assigned by Section 504.502.
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, if
- 11 the department issues a certificate of title for a custom vehicle or
- 12 street rod, the model year of the vehicle must be listed on the
- 13 certificate of title and must be the model year that the body of the
- 14 vehicle resembles. The certificate of title must also include the
- 15 word "replica."
- (c) The owner of the custom vehicle or street rod shall
- 17 provide the department with documentation identifying the model
- 18 year that the body of the vehicle resembles.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 504.502, Transportation Code, is amended
- 20 by amending Subsections (a), (b), and (i) and adding Subsections
- 21 (f-1) and (f-2) to read as follows:
- 22 (a) The department shall issue specialty license plates for
- 23 a passenger car, truck, motorcycle, or former military vehicle
- 24 that:

(1) is at least 25 years old, if the vehicle is a 1 passenger car, truck, or motorcycle or is a street rod or custom 2 3 vehicle; 4 (2) is a collector's item; 5 (3) is used exclusively for exhibitions, club activities, parades, and other functions of public interest and is 6 not used for regular transportation; and 7 8 (4) does not carry advertising. The license plates must include the words "Antique 9 Auto," "Antique Truck," "Antique Motorcycle," "Street Rod," 10 "Custom Vehicle," or "Military Vehicle," as appropriate. 11 12 (f-1) Notwithstanding Chapter 547, a custom vehicle or street rod eligible to receive license plates under this section is 13 not required to be equipped with a specific piece of equipment 14 unless the specific piece of equipment was required by statute as a 15 condition of sale during the year listed as the model year on the 16 17 certificate of title. (f-2) On initial registration of a custom vehicle or street 18 rod, the owner must provide proof, acceptable to the department, 19 that the custom vehicle or street rod passed a safety inspection 20 that has been approved by the department. The department shall 21 create a safety inspection process for inspecting custom vehicles 22 and street rods. 23

13	country's military forces; and
14	(B) $[(2)$] is maintained to represent its
15	military design and markings accurately.
16	(3) "Street rod" means a vehicle:
17	(A) that was manufactured:
18	(i) before 1949; or
19	(ii) after 1948 to resemble a vehicle
20	manufactured before 1949; and
21	(B) that:
22	(i) has been altered from the
23	manufacturer's original design; or
24	(ii) has a body constructed from materials
25	not original to the vehicle.
26	SECTION 3. Section 548.052, Transportation Code, is amended
27	to read as follows:

- 2 chapter does not apply to:
- 3 (1) a trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, or mobile
- 4 home moving under or bearing a current factory-delivery license
- 5 plate or current in-transit license plate;
- 6 (2) a vehicle moving under or bearing a paper dealer
- 7 in-transit tag, machinery license, disaster license, parade
- 8 license, prorate tab, one-trip permit, antique license, custom
- 9 vehicle license, street rod license, temporary 24-hour permit, or
- 10 permit license;
- 11 (3) a trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, or mobile
- 12 home having an actual gross weight or registered gross weight of
- 13 4,500 pounds or less;
- 14 (4) farm machinery, road-building equipment, a farm
- 15 trailer, or a vehicle required to display a slow-moving-vehicle
- 16 emblem under Section 547.703;
- 17 (5) a former military vehicle, as defined by Section
- 18 504.502(i) [502.275];
- 19 (6) a vehicle qualified for a tax exemption under
- 20 Section 152.092, Tax Code; or
- 21 (7) a vehicle for which a certificate of title has been
- 22 issued but that is not required to be registered.
- SECTION 4. Section 504.502, Transportation Code, as amended
- 24 by this Act, applies only to a registration period beginning on or
- 25 after the effective date of this Act.
- 26 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
