## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the marketing, hosting, and sale of specialty and
- 3 personalized license plates.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 504.101(a-1), Transportation Code, is
- 6 added to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 504.101. PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES.
- 8 <u>(a-1)</u> The department shall issue personalized license
- 9 plates, including those sold by the private vendor as provided by
- 10 <u>Section 504.851.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 504.6011(a) and (b), Transportation
- 12 Code, are amended and Subsection (d) is added to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 504.6011. GENERAL PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO SPECIALTY
- 14 LICENSE PLATES FOR GENERAL DISTRIBUTION SOLD THROUGH PRIVATE
- 15 VENDOR. (a) The sponsor of a specialty license plate [authorized
- 16 to be issued under this subchapter before September 1, 2009, and
- 17 contract with the private vendor authorized under Subchapter J for
- 18 the marketing and sale of the specialty license plate. The
- 19 department by rule may establish an implementation date for the
- 20 program.
- 21 (b) After the implementation date set by board rule, in
- 22 <u>accordance with Subsection (a), the [The]</u> fee for issuance of a
- 23 specialty license plate [described by Subsection (a)] is the amount
- 24 established under Section 504.851.

- 1 (d) If the contract entered into under Subsection (a)
- 2 terminates, the sponsor of a specialty license plate may
- 3 re-establish its statutory plate in accordance with Sections
- 4 504.601 and 504.702 and be credited its previous deposit with the
- 5 department.
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 504.614(b-1), Transportation Code, is
- 7 added to read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) The public entity that is distributed funds under
- 9 Subsection (b) may contract with the private vendor, pursuant to
- 10 Sec. 504.6011, to distribute the public entity's portion of the
- 11 funds in a manner other than that described in subsection (b).
- 12 SECTION 4. The heading of Section 504.802, Transportation
- 13 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 504.802. Marketing and Sale by Private Vendor of
- 15 Specialty License Plates [Created before September 1, 2009].
- SECTION 5. Section 504.802(a) and (c), Transportation Code,
- 17 are amended and Subsection (d) is added to read as follows:
- 18 (a) A sponsor of a specialty license plate [created under
- 19 this subchapter before September 1, 2009, may contract with the
- 20 private vendor authorized under Subchapter J for the marketing and
- 21 sale of the specialty license plate.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other law, from each fee received
- 23 from the issuance of a specialty license plate marketed and sold by
- 24 the private vendor under this section, the department shall:
- 25 (1) deduct the administrative costs described by
- 26 Section 504.801(e)(1);
- 27 (2) deposit the portion of the fee for the sale of the

- 1 plate that the state would ordinarily receive under the contract
- 2 described by Section 504.851(a) to the credit of:
- 3 (A) the specialty license plate fund, if the
- 4 sponsor nominated a state agency or a public entity to receive the
- 5 funds; or
- 6 (B) the general revenue fund, if the sponsor did
- 7 not nominate a state agency or a public entity to receive the funds,
- 8 or if there is no sponsor; and
- 9 (3) pay to the private vendor the remainder of the fee.
- 10 (d) If the contract entered into under Subsection (a)
- 11 terminates, the sponsor of a specialty license plate may
- 12 re-establish its statutory plate in accordance with Sections
- 13 504.601 and 504.702 and be credited its previous deposit with the
- 14 department.
- 15 SECTION 6. Sections 504.851 (a-2), (c), and (e), (f), (h),
- 16 Transportation Code, are amended and Subsections (a-3) and (n) are
- 17 added to read as follows:
- 18 (a-2) Specialty license plates authorized for marketing and
- 19 sale under Subsection (a) may [must] include personalization and
- 20 must include:
- 21 (1) specialty license plates created under
- 22 Subchapters G and I before the implementation date set by
- 23 <u>department rule</u> [on or after September 1, 2009]; and
- 24 (2) at the request of the specialty license plate
- 25 sponsor, an existing specialty license plate created under
- 26 Subchapters G and I before the implementation date set by
- 27 <u>department rule</u> [September 1, 2009].

- 1 (a-3) The department may contract with the private vendor:
- 2 (1) to host all or some of the specialty plates on its
- 3 website by processing the specialty plate and paying any additional
- 4 transaction cost; and
- 5 (2) share in the personalization fee for the hosted
- 6 plates.
- 7 (c) The board by rule shall establish the fees for the
- 8 issuance or renewal of souvenir license plates, specialty license
- 9 plates, or souvenir or specialty license plates that are
- 10 personalized that are marketed and sold by the private vendor or
- 11 hosted on the private vendor's website. The state's portion of the
- 12 personalization fee may not be less than \$40 for each year issued.
- 13 Other fees [Fees] must be reasonable and not less than the amounts
- 14 necessary to allow the department to recover all reasonable costs
- 15 to the department associated with the evaluation of the competitive
- 16 sealed proposals received by the department and with the
- 17 implementation and enforcement of the contract, including direct,
- 18 indirect, and administrative costs. A fee established under this
- 19 subsection is in addition to:
- 20 (1) the registration fee and any optional registration
- 21 fee prescribed by this chapter for the vehicle for which specialty
- 22 license plates are issued;
- 23 (2) any additional fee prescribed by this subchapter
- 24 for the issuance of specialty license plates for that vehicle; and
- 25 (3) any additional fee prescribed by this subchapter
- 26 for the issuance of personalized license plates for that vehicle.
- (e) The portion of a contract with a private vendor

- 1 regarding the marketing and sale of personalized license plates is
- 2 payable only from amounts derived from the collection of the fee
- 3 established under Subsection (b). The portion of a contract with a
- 4 private vendor regarding the marketing, hosting, and sale of
- 5 souvenir license plates, specialty license plates, or souvenir or
- 6 specialty license plates that are personalized under Section
- 7 504.102 is payable only from amounts derived from the collection of
- 8 the fee established under Subsection (c).
- 9 (f) The department may approve new design and color
- 10 combinations for personalized or specialty license plates that are
- 11 marketed and sold by a private vendor under a contract entered into
- 12 with the private vendor. Each approved license plate design and
- 13 color combination remains the property of the department.
- (h) Subject to the limitations provided by Subsections (g)
- 15 and (g-1), the department may <u>disapprove</u> a <u>design</u>, cancel a license
- 16 plate, or require the discontinuance of a license plate design or
- 17 color combination that is marketed, hosted, or [and] sold by a
- 18 private vendor under contract at any time if the department
- 19 determines that the <u>disapproval</u>, cancellation, or discontinuation
- 20 is in the best interest of the state or the motoring public.
- 21 <u>(n) If the private vendor ceases operation:</u>
- 22 (1) the program may be operated by the department
- 23 under new agreements with the plate sponsors until another vendor
- 24 <u>is selected and commences operation; and</u>
- 25 (2) the private vendor's share of the revenue is
- 26 deposited to the credit of general revenue.
- 27 SECTION 7. The heading of Section 504.853, Transportation

- 1 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 2 <u>Sec. 504.853.</u> Specialty and Personalized License Plates
- 3 Issued Before the Implementation Date [September 1, 2009].
- 4 SECTION 8. Section 504.853(a), (b), (c), and (e),
- 5 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows: (a) A
- 6 specialty or personalized license plate issued before the
- 7 <u>implementation date set by board rule</u> [September 1, 2009], may be
- 8 issued for a subsequent registration period only if the applicant
- 9 submits an application and pays the required fees for the
- 10 applicable registration period. A person who is issued a specialty
- 11 or personalized license plate has first priority on the license
- 12 plate for each subsequent registration period for which the person
- 13 submits a new application for that plate.
- 14 (b) Unless the Board adopts by rule a higher fee or the plate
- 15 <u>is not renewed annually, the</u> [The] fee for issuance of a
- 16 [personalized] license plate issued before the implementation date
- 17 set by board rule [September 1, 2099], is:
- (1) as provided in Section 504.601 for a specialty
- 19 plate; and
- 20 (2) \$40 for a personalized plate, [unless the director
- 21 adopts by rule a higher fee].
- (c) A person who is issued a specialty or personalized
- 23 license plate by the department before the implementation date set
- 24 by board rule [September 1, 2009], may:
- 25 (1) submit an application for the plate under
- 26 Subsection (a) and pay the required fee for each subsequent
- 27 registration period under Subsection (b); or

- 1 (2) purchase through the private vendor a license to
- 2 display the alphanumeric pattern on a license plate for any term
- 3 allowed by law.
- 4 (e) Of each fee collected by the department under subsection
- 5 (b) of this section:
- 6 (1) \$1.25 shall be used by the department to defray the
- 7 cost of administering this section; and
- 8 (2) the remainder shall be deposited to the credit of
- 9 the general revenue fund.
- SECTION 9. Section 504.854(a) and (b), Transportation Code,
- 11 are amended as follows:
- 12 (a) The board by rule [private vendor] may provide for the
- 13 private vendor to:
- 14 (1) sell at auction a license to display a unique
- 15 alphanumeric pattern on a license plate for a maximum period;
- 16 (2) reserve an unissued alphanumeric pattern from the
- 17 department for purposes of auction for a period set by the board;
- 18 and
- 19 (3) purchase an existing alphanumeric pattern from the
- 20 customer to whom it is issued before its renewal date for purposes
- 21 of auction.
- (b)  $\underline{A}$  [Only a] license to display an alphanumeric pattern
- 23 purchased under this section [or a license to display an
- 24 alphanumeric pattern sold by the private vendor under Section
- 25 504.853] may be transferred to another person without payment of
- 26 the fee provided by Section 504.855. [The transferee is entitled to
- 27 the same rights and privileges as the transferor.

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- 1 SECTION 10. Subchapter J, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,
- 2 is amended by adding Section 504.855 to read as follows:
- 3 <u>Sec. 504.855. TRANSFERABILITY OF CERTAIN PATTERNS. The</u>
- 4 board by rule may:
- 5 (1) authorize any person who purchases a license plate
- 6 that displays an alphanumeric pattern for a period of five years or
- 7 more to transfer the alphanumeric pattern; and
- 8 (2) establish a transfer fee to be distributed in
- 9 accordance with the contract with the private vendor.
- 10 SECTION 11. The following provisions of the Transportation
- 11 Code are repealed:
- 12 (1) Section 504.851(b) as amended by Acts 2009, 81st
- 13 Leg., Regular Session, ch. 933;
- 14 (2) Section 504.851(f) and (k); and
- 15 (3) Section 504.854(c), Transportation Code.
- 16 SECTION 12. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
