## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to coverage for certain pharmaceutical services by a 3 workers' compensation insurance carrier.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 413.0141, Labor Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:

Sec. 413.0141. 7 INITIAL PHARMACEUTICAL COVERAGE. The commissioner may by rule provide that an insurance carrier shall 8 provide for payment of specified pharmaceutical services through 9 [sufficient for] the seventh working day after [first seven days 10 11 following] the date of injury if the health care provider requests 12 and receives verification of insurance coverage and a verbal confirmation of an injury from the employer or from the insurance 13 14 carrier as provided by Section 413.014. The rules adopted by the commissioner shall provide that an insurance carrier is eligible 15 16 for reimbursement for pharmaceutical services paid under this section from the subsequent injury fund in the event the injury is 17 determined not to be compensable. 18

19 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 20 pharmaceutical services provided in conjunction with a claim for 21 workers' compensation benefits based on a compensable injury that 22 occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. Pharmaceutical 23 services provided in conjunction with a claim based on a 24 compensable injury that occurs before that date are governed by the

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law in effect on the date the compensable injury occurred, and the
former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
