4	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 2171, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 2171.1011 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 2171.1011. CENTRALIZED FLEET MANAGEMENT. (a) The
7	comptroller shall devise and implement a statewide system of state
8	agency vehicle fleet management, including the following
9	<pre>functions:</pre>
10	(1) vehicle acquisition and maintenance and repair
11	activities, including preventive maintenance;
12	(2) fueling operations;
13	(3) management of inventory and the use, collection,
14	and reporting of data; and
15	(4) disposal or sale of excess inventory.
16	(b) The comptroller may negotiate a contract with a private
17	<pre>fleet management provider:</pre>
18	(1) to operate one or all of the fleet management
19	functions of the agency; or
20	(2) for fleet management data software and services,
21	if the provider can demonstrate expertise necessary to perform the
22	functions required by Subsection (a).
23	SECTION 2. The following sections of the Government Code
