3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 51.002, Utilities Code, is amended by
5	adding Subdivisions (3-a) and (13) to read as follows:
6	(3-a) "Internet Protocol enabled service" means a
7	service, capability, functionality, or application that uses
8	Internet Protocol or a successor protocol to allow an end user to
9	send or receive a data, video, or voice communication in Internet
10	Protocol or a successor protocol.
11	(13) "Voice over Internet Protocol service" means a
12	<pre>service that:</pre>
13	(A) uses Internet Protocol or a successor
14	protocol to enable a real-time, two-way voice communication that
15	originates from or terminates to the user's location in Internet
16	<pre>Protocol or a successor protocol;</pre>
17	(B) requires the use of a broadband connection
18	<pre>from the user's location; and</pre>
19	(C) permits a user generally to receive a call
20	that originates on the public switched telephone network and to
21	terminate a call to the public switched telephone network.
22	SECTION 2. Section 52.002, Utilities Code, is amended by
23	adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:

(c) Notwithstanding any other law, a department, agency, or

- 1 political subdivision of this state may not by rule, order, or other
- 2 means directly or indirectly regulate rates charged for, service or
- 3 contract terms for, conditions for, or requirements for entry into
- 4 the market for Voice over Internet Protocol services or other

- 6 (1) affect payment of rights-of-way fees applicable to
- 7 <u>Voice over Internet Protocol services under Chapter 283, Local</u>

- 9 (2) affect any person's obligation to provide video
- 10 service, as defined by Section 66.002, under any applicable state
- 11 or federal law; or
- 12 (3) require or prohibit assessment of enhanced 9-1-1,
- 13 relay access service, or universal service fund fees on Voice over
- 14 Internet Protocol service.
- 15 (d) Payment of switched access rates or other intercarrier
- 16 compensation rates, as applicable, with respect to Voice over
- 17 Internet Protocol services or other Internet Protocol enabled
- 18 services, shall be as determined through commercial agreements or
- 19 by the Federal Communications Commission.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
