- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 202, Property Code, is amended by adding

- 8 A property owners' association may not, except as provided by this
- 9 section, adopt or enforce a dedicatory instrument provision that
- 10 prohibits, restricts, or has the effect of prohibiting or
- 11 restricting a property owner from installing a liquid propane gas
- 12 tank above ground on the owner's residential property if the tank is
- 13 <u>a size reasonably necessary to meet the gas requirements of the</u>
- 14 residence.
- 15 (b) The property owners' association may require the owner
- 16 to screen the tank from view with reasonable screening materials.
- 17 SECTION 2. Chapter 250, Local Government Code, is amended
- 18 by adding Section 250.007 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 250.007. REGULATION OF LIQUID PROPANE GAS TANKS ON
- 20 RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY. (a) A municipality or county may not, except
- 21 as provided by this section, enact or enforce an order or ordinance
- 22 that prohibits, restricts, or has the effect of prohibiting or
- 23 restricting a property owner from installing a liquid propane gas

- 1 <u>a size reasonably necessary to meet the gas requirements of the</u>

- 3 (b) The municipality or county may require the owner to
- 4 screen the tank from view with reasonable screening materials.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
