- 2 relating to prima facie speed limits.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 545.352(b), Transportation Code, as
- 5 amended by Chapters 663 (H.B. 385), 739 (H.B. 1075), and 1346 (H.B.
- 6 676), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999, is
- 7 reenacted to read as follows:
- 8 (b) Unless a special hazard exists that requires a slower
- 9 speed for compliance with Section 545.351(b), the following speeds
- 10 are lawful:
- 11 (1) 30 miles per hour in an urban district on a street
- 12 other than an alley and 15 miles per hour in an alley;
- 13 (2) 70 miles per hour in daytime and 65 miles per hour
- 14 in nighttime if the vehicle is a passenger car, motorcycle,
- 15 passenger car or light truck towing a trailer bearing a vessel, as
- 16 defined by Section 31.003, Parks and Wildlife Code, that is less
- 17 than 26 feet in length, passenger car or light truck towing a
- 18 trailer or semitrailer used primarily to transport a motorcycle, or
- 19 passenger car or light truck towing a trailer or semitrailer
- 20 <u>designed</u> and used primarily to transport dogs or livestock, on a
- 21 highway numbered by this state or the United States outside an urban
- 22 district, including a farm-to-market or ranch-to-market road;
- 23 except as provided by Subdivision (4);
- 24 (3) 60 miles per hour in daytime and 55 miles per hour

- 1 in nighttime if the vehicle is on a highway that is outside an urban
- 2 district and not a highway numbered by this state or the United
- 3 States;
- 4 (4) outside an urban district:
- 5 (A) 60 miles per hour if the vehicle is a school
- 6 bus that has passed a commercial motor vehicle inspection under
- 7 Section 548.201 and is on a highway numbered by the United States or
- 8 this state, including a farm-to-market road;
- 9 (B) 50 miles per hour if the vehicle is a school
- 10 bus that:
- 11 (i) has not passed a commercial motor
- 12 vehicle inspection under Section 548.201; or
- 13 (ii) is traveling on a highway not numbered
- 14 by the United States or this state; or
- 15 (C) 60 miles per hour in daytime and 55 miles per
- 16 hour in nighttime if:
- 17 (i) the vehicle is a truck, other than a
- 18 light truck, or if the vehicle is a truck tractor, trailer, or
- 19 semitrailer; and
- 20 (ii) the vehicle is on a farm-to-market or
- 21 ranch-to-market road;
- 22 (5) on a beach, 15 miles per hour; or
- 23 (6) on a county road adjacent to a public beach, 15
- 24 miles per hour, if declared by the commissioners court of the
- 25 county.
- 26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
