- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 370.004(a), Local Government Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A peace officer employed by a political subdivision of
- 7 this state who investigates or responds to an incident in which a
- 8 motor vehicle damages a fence shall, if the peace officer
- 9 reasonably believes that the fence is intended to contain livestock
- 10 or other animals:
- 11 (1) immediately determine the owner of the land on
- 12 which the damaged fence is located; [and]
- 13 (2) notify the owner of the type and extent of the
- 14 damage, if the owner has registered with the political subdivision
- 15 in accordance with Subsection (c); and
- 16 (3) remain at the location of the damaged fence until:
- 17 (A) the peace officer or another person makes
- 18 reasonable attempts to secure the fence; or
- 19 (B) the landowner or landowner's representative
- 20 <u>arrives at the scene</u>.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
