- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2301, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 2301.010 to read as follows:

- 7 Sec. 2301.010. CONTRACTUAL LIMITATIONS PERIOD AND CLAIM
- 8 FILING PERIOD IN CERTAIN PROPERTY INSURANCE FORMS. (a) A policy
- 9 form or printed endorsement form for residential or commercial
- 10 property insurance that is filed by an insurer or adopted by the
- 11 department under this subchapter may provide for a contractual
- 12 <u>limitations period for filing suit on a first-party claim under the</u>
- 13 policy. The contractual limitations period may not end before the
- 14 earlier of:

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- 15 (1) two years from the date the insurer accepts or
- 16 rejects the claim; or
- 17 (2) three years from the date of the loss that is the
- 18 subject of the claim.
- 19 (b) A policy or endorsement described by Subsection (a) may
- 20 contain a provision requiring that a claim be filed with the insurer
- 21 not later than one year after the date of the loss that is the
- 22 subject of the claim.
- 23 (c) A contractual provision contrary to Subsection (a) is
- 24 void. This subsection does not affect the validity of other

- 4 Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection
- 5 (c) to read as follows:
- 6 (a) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [<u>Subsection</u>] (b) <u>and</u>
- 7 (c), a person may not enter a stipulation, contract, or agreement
- 8 that purports to limit the time in which to bring suit on the
- 9 stipulation, contract, or agreement to a period shorter than two
- 10 years. A stipulation, contract, or agreement that establishes a
- 11 limitations period that is shorter than two years is void in this
- 12 state.
- 13 <u>(c) This section does not apply to a residential or</u>
- 14 commercial property insurance policy that complies with Section
- 15 <u>2301.010</u>, Insurance Code.
- SECTION 3. Section 2301.010, Insurance Code, as added by
- 17 this Act, applies only to an insurance policy that is delivered,
- 18 issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2012. A
- 19 policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1,
- 20 2012, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 21 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 22 that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
