17	higher education with a wide range of admissions criteria; and
18	(B) the availability of various types of
19	financial aid and the qualifications for obtaining those various
20	types of aid;
21	(2) instruction designed to prepare students for
22	successful performance on a specific college entrance examination;

24	(3) instruction on various forms of writing,

- 1 <u>especially essay writing</u>, at the college level.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
