1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the appointment of a court reporter by a criminal law
1-9 magistrate in Bexar County.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 52, Government Code, is
1-12 amended by adding Section 52.0441 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 52.0441. COURT REPORTERS FOR CRIMINAL LAW MAGISTRATES
1-14 IN BEXAR COUNTY. Each full-time Bexar County criminal law
1-15 magistrate, with the consent and approval of the Commissioners
1-16 Court of Bexar County, may appoint an official court reporter to
1-17 serve that magistrate. The reporter is a sworn officer of the court
1-18 who holds office at the pleasure of the magistrate.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect October 1, 2011.
