(e) The terms of the 37th, 45th, 57th, 73rd, 131st, 150th, 17 166th, 224th, 225th, 285th, [and] 288th, 407th, 408th, and 438th 18 district courts begin on the first Mondays in January and July. 19 (e-1) The 386th and 436th district courts shall give 20 preference to juvenile matters under Title 3, Family Code. The 21 terms of those courts begin on the first Mondays in July and 22 23 January. Each term continues until the court has disposed of the business for that term. 24
