- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 24.139(b), (d), and (e), Government
- 5 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (b) This section applies to the 37th, 45th, 57th, 73rd,
- 7 131st, 144th, 150th, 166th, 175th, 186th, 187th, 224th, 225th,
- 8 226th, 227th, 285th, 288th, 289th, [and] 290th, 379th, 386th,
- 9 399th, 407th, 408th, 436th, 437th, and 438th district courts in
- 10 Bexar County.
- 11 (d) The 144th, 175th, 186th, 187th, 226th, 227th, 289th,
- 12 [and] 290th, 379th, 386th, 399th, 436th, and 437th district courts
- 13 shall give preference to criminal cases. The terms of those courts
- 14 begin on the first Mondays in January and July. Each term continues
- 15 until the court has disposed of the business for that term.
- 16 (e) The terms of the 37th, 45th, 57th, 73rd, 131st, 150th,
- 17 166th, 224th, 225th, 285th, [and] 288th, 407th, 408th, and 438th
- 18 district courts begin on the first Mondays in January and July.
