1-13 SECTION 1. Section 552.116(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

1**-**14 1**-**15 An audit working paper of an audit of the state auditor (a) 1-16 or the auditor of a state agency, an institution of higher education 1-17 as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, a county, a municipality, a school district, <u>a hospital district</u>, or a joint board operating under Section 22.074, Transportation Code, including any audit relating to the criminal history background check of a public school employee, is excepted from the 1-18 1-19 1-20 1-21 requirements of Section 552.021. If information in an audit working paper is also maintained in another record, that other 1-22 1-23 1**-**24 1**-**25 record is not excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021 by this section.

SECTION 2. Section 552.116(b)(1), Government 1-26 Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-27

board described by Subsection (a) and includes an investigation. SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to an 1-37 1-38 audit working paper created before, on, or after the effective date 1-39 of this Act.

1-40 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-41 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-42 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-43 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-44 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
