Section 522.004(a), Transportation Code, 17 is amended to read as follows: 18 (a) This chapter does not apply to: 19 (1) a vehicle that is controlled and operated by a 20 21 farmer and: 22 (A) used to transport agricultural products, farm machinery, or farm supplies to or from a farm; and 23 (B) [used within 150 miles of the person's farm; 24
