## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article 56.065, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 8 (j) A communication or record that contains identifying
- 9 <u>information regarding a person who receives a forensic medical</u>
- 10 examination under this article and that is created by, provided to,
- 11 or in the control or possession of the department is confidential
- 12 for purposes of Section 552.101, Government Code. In this
- 13 <u>subsection</u>, "identifying information" includes:
- 14 (1) information revealing the identity, personal
- 15 history, or background of the person; or
- 16 (2) information concerning the victimization of the
- 17 person.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
