5	SECTION 1. Section 352.081, Local Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (f-1) to read as follows:
7	(f-1) The commissioners court of a county may provide
8	exemptions from an order adopted by the county under this section.
9	The exemptions may include any of the following:
0	(1) prescribed burns conducted by specific prescribed

- 10 (1) prescribed burns conducted by specific prescribed 11 burn associations;
- (2) outdoor burning by specific state agency
- 13 landowners; and

 (3) outdoor burning by private landowners who, as the

 15 commissioners court in its discretion finds, demonstrate the

 16 knowledge, experience, planning, personnel, liability insurance,

 17 and equipment to safely conduct a planned prescribed burn during

 18 the period during which burning is prohibited or restricted, in

 19 accordance with prescribed burning conditions and standards
- described by Chapter 153, Natural Resources Code.

 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
