## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the assessment of litigation costs in certain actions
- 3 under the public information law.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.323(b), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) In an action brought under Section 552.324, the court
- 8 may assess costs of litigation and reasonable attorney's fees
- 9 incurred by a plaintiff or defendant who substantially
- 10 prevails. In exercising its discretion under this subsection, the
- 11 court shall consider whether the conduct of the governmental body
- 12 had a reasonable basis in law  $\underline{\text{or}}$  [and] whether the litigation was
- 13 brought in good faith.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to an action commenced on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 An action commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 18 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
