A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to a fixed tuition rate program for certain students who
3 transfer to a state university after completing an associate degree
4 program.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
7 amended by adding Section 54.016 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 54.016. FIXED TUITION RATE PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN
9 TRANSFER STUDENTS AT GENERAL ACADEMIC TEACHING INSTITUTIONS. (a)

10 In this section:

11 (1) "Coordinating board" means the Texas Higher
12 Education Coordinating Board.

13 (2) "General academic teaching institution" has the
14 meaning assigned by Section 61.003.

15 (3) "Lower-division institution of higher education"
16 means a public junior college, public state college, or public
17 technical institute.

18 (b) A general academic teaching institution may develop a
19 fixed tuition rate program for qualified students who agree to
20 transfer to the institution within 12 months after successfully
21 earning an associate degree at a lower-division institution of
22 higher education. Under a program developed under this section, a
23 general academic teaching institution must:

24 (1) guarantee to a participating student enrolled in

1 an associate degree program at a lower-division institution of
2 higher education, on successful completion of the associate degree
3 program, transfer admission to the general academic teaching
4 institution within the period prescribed above; and

5 (2) notwithstanding any other provision of this
6 chapter, charge tuition to a participating student for any semester
7 or other academic term at the same rate the general academic
8 teaching institution would have charged to the student during the
9 later of:

10 (A) the fall semester of the student's freshman
11 year at another institution of higher education had the student
12 entered the general academic teaching institution as a freshman
13 student; or

14 (B) the fall semester of the second academic year
15 preceding the academic year of the student's initial enrollment in
16 the general academic teaching institution.

17 (c) A general academic teaching institution that develops a
18 fixed tuition rate program under this section shall prescribe
19 eligibility requirements for participation in the program and
20 notify applicants for transfer admission from lower-division
21 institutions of higher education regarding the program.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
26 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
