## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to a fixed tuition rate program for certain students who
- 3 transfer to a state university after completing an associate degree
- 4 program.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 54.016 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 54.016. FIXED TUITION RATE PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN
- 9 TRANSFER STUDENTS AT GENERAL ACADEMIC TEACHING INSTITUTIONS. (a)
- 10 In this section:
- 11 (1) "Coordinating board" means the Texas Higher
- 12 Education Coordinating Board.
- 13 (2) "General academic teaching institution" has the
- 14 meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- 15 (3) "Lower-division institution of higher education"
- 16 means a public junior college, public state college, or public
- 17 technical institute.
- 18 (b) A general academic teaching institution may develop a
- 19 fixed tuition rate program for qualified students who agree to
- 20 transfer to the institution after successfully earning an associate
- 21 degree at a lower-division institution of higher education. Under
- 22 <u>a program developed under this section</u>, a general academic teaching
- 23 institution must:
- 24 (1) guarantee to a participating student enrolled in

- 1 an associate degree program at a lower-division institution of
- 2 higher education, on successful completion of the associate degree
- 3 program, transfer admission to the general academic teaching
- 4 institution and acceptance into the student's degree program of
- 5 choice; and
- 6 (2) notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 7 chapter, charge tuition to a participating student for any semester
- 8 or other academic term at the same rate the general academic
- 9 teaching institution would have charged to the student during the
- 10 fall semester of the student's freshman year at another institution
- 11 of higher education had the student entered the general academic
- 12 teaching institution as a freshman student.
- 13 (c) A general academic teaching institution that develops a
- 14 fixed tuition rate program under this section shall prescribe
- 15 eligibility requirements for participation in the program and
- 16 <u>notify applicants for transfer admission from lower-division</u>
- 17 institutions of higher education regarding the program.
- 18 (d) In consultation with general academic teaching
- 19 institutions, the coordinating board shall adopt any rules the
- 20 coordinating board considers appropriate for the administration of
- 21 this section.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
