Section 12.1331, Education Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows: 6 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a 7 charter holder may reduce the salary of a classroom teacher, 8 9 full-time speech-language pathologist, full-time librarian, full-time counselor, or full-time school nurse by an amount not to 10 exceed 10 percent of the sum paid to the teacher, speech-language 11 pathologist, librarian, counselor, or school nurse in the 2011-2012 12 13 school year. 14 SECTION 2. Section 19.009, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d-4) to read as follows: 15 16 (d-4) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the district may reduce the salary of a classroom teacher, 17 full-time speech-language pathologist, full-time librarian, 18 full-time counselor, or full-time school nurse by an amount not to 19 exceed 10 percent of the sum paid to the teacher, speech-language 20 pathologist, librarian, counselor, or school nurse in the 2011-2012 21 school year. The commissioner may reduce the amount of state aid 22 23 provided to the district under Section 19.007(g), as appropriate. 24 SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 21, Education Code, is

3 SECTION 10. Section 21.402(d), Education Code, is repealed.
4 SECTION 11. This Act applies beginning with the 2012-2013
5 school year.

6 SECTION 12. This Act takes effect immediately if it 7 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each 8 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 9 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate 10 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
