- 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.023(c-3), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (c-3) In adopting a schedule for the administration of
- 8 assessment instruments under this section, the State Board of
- 9 Education shall require:
- 10 (1) assessment instruments [administered] under
- 11 Subsection (a) to be administered on a schedule so that the first
- 12 assessment instrument is administered at least two weeks later than
- 13 the date on which the first assessment instrument was administered
- 14 under Subsection (a) during the 2006-2007 school year; [and]
- 15 (2) the spring administration of end-of-course
- 16 assessment instruments under Subsection (c) to occur in each school
- 17 district not earlier than the first full week in May, except that
- 18 the spring administration of the end-of-course assessment
- 19 instruments in English I, English II, and English III must be
- 20 permitted to occur at an earlier date; and
- 21 (3) the administration of assessment instruments
- 22 <u>under Subsection (a) and end-of-course assessment instruments</u>
- 23 under Subsection (c), including any administration of an assessment
- 24 instrument for students who did not participate in the regular

- 1 administration or who failed to perform satisfactorily on the
- 2 assessment instrument, to occur only on a weekday.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
