H.B. No. 3022

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to the appointment of a bailiff for the 196th District  
3 Court.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 53.002(a), Government Code, is amended  
6 to read as follows:

7 (a) The judges of the 34th, 86th, 130th, 142nd, 196th,  
8 238th, 318th, 355th, and 385th district courts may each appoint a  
9 bailiff.

10 SECTION 2. Section 53.009(b), Government Code, is amended  
11 to read as follows:

12 (b) Each bailiff appointed by a judge of the 142nd, 196th,  
13 238th, 318th, or 385th district court is entitled to receive from  
14 each county in which the court sits the amount of compensation set  
15 by the judge in an amount that does not exceed the salary of the  
16 chief deputy sheriff of the county. The judge shall give each  
17 commissioners court in the district written notification of the  
18 amount of compensation to be paid by the county.

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
