16 <u>(c) The commission shall market and advertise the lottery</u> 17 game operated under this section in a manner intended to inform the 18 public that the game tickets are available for purchase and that the 19 game proceeds are used to fund breast cancer research, education, 20 and patient treatment and support. The Department of State Health 21 <u>Services may make recommendations to the commission relating to the</u> 22 marketing and advertising of the game.

(d) The commission shall encourage each sales agent that
 sells tickets to instant-ticket games or similar types of lottery
 games to sell tickets to the game operated under this section.

26 SECTION 3. Section 466.355(b), Government Code, is amended 27 to read as follows:

(b) Money in the state lottery account may be used only forthe following purposes and shall be distributed as follows:

3 (1) the payment of prizes to the holders of winning
4 tickets;

5 (2) the payment of costs incurred in the operation and 6 administration of the lottery, including any fees received by a 7 lottery operator, provided that the costs incurred in a fiscal 8 biennium may not exceed an amount equal to 12 percent of the gross 9 revenue accruing from the sale of tickets in that biennium;

10 (3) the establishment of a pooled bond fund, lottery 11 prize reserve fund, unclaimed prize fund, and prize payment 12 account; and

13 (4) the balance, after creation of a reserve 14 sufficient to pay the amounts needed or estimated to be needed under 15 Subdivisions (1) through (3), to be transferred on or before the 16 15th day of each month as follows:

(A) the portion of the balance attributable to
the lottery game operated under Section 466.027 to the fund for
veterans' assistance established by Section 434.017; [and]

20 (B) <u>the portion of the balance attributable to</u> 21 <u>the lottery game operated under Section 466.028 to the Pink for Ever</u> 22 <u>fund established by Section 403.110; and</u>

(C) the remainder to the foundation school fund.
 SECTION 4. Chapter 86, Health and Safety Code, is amended by

26SUBCHAPTER D. PINK FOR EVER GRANT PROGRAM27Sec. 86.151. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "department"

The department 3 shall develop and administer a program to award grants to public and nonprofit organizations that: 4 5 (1) provide treatment and support services for breast 6 cancer patients; 7 (2) increase public awareness of breast cancer; or 8 (3) conduct breast cancer research. Sec. 86.153. RULES. The executive commissioner of the 9 Health and Human Services Commission shall adopt rules governing 10 the operation of the grant program and selection of grant 11 12 recipients, subject to the requirements of this subchapter. Sec. 86.157. ADVISORY COMMITTEE. The department may
 appoint an advisory committee to assist in the evaluation of
 applications for grants under this subchapter.

10 SECTION 5. (a) Section 466.355, Government Code, as 11 amended by this Act, applies only to a transfer from the state 12 lottery account made on or after the effective date of this Act.

(b) The Texas Lottery Commission shall establish and begin
selling tickets to the lottery game as required by Section 466.028,
Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than March 1, 2012.

16 (c) Not later than March 1, 2012, the executive commissioner 17 of the Health and Human Services Commission shall adopt necessary 18 rules for, and the Department of State Health Services shall 19 establish and implement, the grant program required under 20 Subchapter D, Chapter 86, Health and Safety Code, as added by this 21 Act.

SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
