5	SECTION 1. Section 371.059, Finance Code, is amended to

7	Sec. 371.059. APPROVAL; ISSUANCE OF LICENSE. <u>The</u> [(a)
8	Subject to Subsection (b), the] commissioner shall approve the
9	application and issue a license if the commissioner finds that the
10	applicant is eligible for the license.
11	[(b) In a county with a population of 250,000 or more, the
12	commissioner shall approve an application for:
13	[(1) an original license to operate a pawnshop at a
14	facility that is not an existing licensed pawnshop at the time the
15	application is filed if the proposed facility is not located within
16	two miles of a licensed pawnshop;
17	[(2) the relocation of a licensed pawnshop to a
18	facility that is not an existing licensed pawnshop at the time the
19	application is filed if the facility where the pawnshop is to be
20	relocated is not located within one mile of a licensed pawnshop; and
21	[(3) the relocation of a licensed pawnshop if at the
22	time the application is filed the pawnshop has been in operation at
23	its current location for at least three years, and the facility

- 1 its existing location or, if in excess of one mile from its existing
- 2 location, not within one mile of another existing operating
- 3 pawnshop.
- 4 [(c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b)(3), the commissioner
- 5 may approve an application for the relocation of a licensed
- 6 pawnshop that needs to relocate marginally further than one mile
- 7 from its existing location or that at the time the application is
- 8 made has not been in operation in its current location for at least
- 9 three years if the necessity for relocation was caused by
- 10 circumstances beyond the applicant's control.
- 11 [(d) A determination of distance for purposes of this
- 12 section is based on a measurement taken from the front door of a
- 13 facility to the front door of the other facility. For a facility
- 14 not in existence at the time the application is filed, the location
- 15 of the front door of the proposed facility must be indicated on
- 16 architectural drawings or comparable professionally prepared
- 17 drawings depicting the facility and the entire boundary of the lot
- 18 or parcel of land to which the facility is to be attached.
- 19 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 20 an application for a pawnshop license or for the relocation of a
- 21 licensed pawnshop that is filed on or after the effective date of
- 22 this Act. An application for a pawnshop license or for the
- 23 relocation of a licensed pawnshop that is filed before the
- 24 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the
- 25 time the application was filed, and the former law is continued in
- 26 effect for that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
