- within the second degree by affinity or the third degree by 9
- consanguinity, as determined under Subchapter B, Chapter 573, 10
- 11 Government Code, or is registered to vote at the same address as the
- 12 applicant, in which event the offense is a Class A misdemeanor].
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 14
- An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 15
- governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and 16
- the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 17
- purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 18
- effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 19
- before that date. 20
