A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the retirement benefits for certain members and
- 3 annuitants of the employee class of the Employees Retirement System
- 4 of Texas.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 813.201(b), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (b) A member may not accrue or establish service credit in
- 9 the employee class of membership when the total amount of service
- 10 credit, multiplied by the percentage in effect for computing
- 11 annuities under Section 814.103, 814.105, <u>814.106</u>, or 814.107 would
- 12 exceed the number 100. When the maximum amount of service credit is
- 13 accrued or established by a member in the employee or elected class,
- 14 member and state contributions cease, although the member retains
- 15 membership subject to Section 812.005.
- 16 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 814, Government Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Section 814.106 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 814.106. SERVICE RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN
- 19 MEMBERS TRANSFERRING SERVICE CREDIT TO EMPLOYEE CLASS FROM ELECTED
- 20 CLASS. (a) This section only applies to a member who establishes or
- 21 transfers service credit from the elected class to the employee
- 22 class under Section 813.503.
- 23 (b) Notwithstanding Section 814.105 or any other law, the
- 24 standard service retirement annuity for a member subject to this

- 1 section is an amount computed as the member's average monthly
- 2 compensation for service performed as a member of the retirement
- 3 system multiplied by 2.3 percent for each year of service credit in
- 4 the system.
- 5 (c) For purposes of Subsection (b), with respect to the
- 6 service credit established or transferred from the elected class, a
- 7 member is assumed to have received the state salary, excluding
- 8 longevity pay payable under Section 659.0445 and as adjusted from
- 9 time to time, being paid a district judge.
- 10 (d) The standard service retirement annuity for service
- 11 credited in the employee class may not be less than \$150 a month nor
- 12 more than 100 percent of the average monthly compensation computed
- 13 under Subsection (b).
- 14 SECTION 3. Section 814.108(a), Government Code, is amended
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 (a) Instead of the standard service retirement annuity
- 17 payable under Section 814.103, [ex] 814.105, or 814.106, the
- 18 standard combined service retirement annuity payable under Section
- 19 814.107, or an annuity actuarially reduced because of age under
- 20 Section 814.107, a retiring member may elect to receive an optional
- 21 service retirement annuity under this section.
- SECTION 4. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 23 only to a member of the Employees Retirement System of Texas who
- 24 retires on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 25 (b) A member of the Employees Retirement System of Texas who
- 26 retires before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 27 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and

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- 1 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
