- 5 SECTION 1. Section 232.008(h), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (h) Regardless of the date land is subdivided or a plat is
- 8 <u>filed for a subdivision, the</u> [The] commissioners court may deny a
- 9 cancellation under this section if the commissioners court
- 10 determines the cancellation will prevent the proposed
- 11 interconnection of infrastructure to pending or existing
- 12 development <u>as defined by Section 232.0085</u>.
- SECTION 2. Section 232.008(h), Local Government Code, as
- 14 amended by this Act, applies to an application for cancellation of
- 15 all or part of a subdivision filed on or after the effective date of
- 16 this Act or before the effective date of this Act if the approval of
- 17 the application filed before the effective date of this Act is not
- 18 final.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
