- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2.005(b), Family Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) The proof must be established by:
- 8 (1) a driver's license or identification card issued
- 9 by this state, another state, or a <u>foreign government</u> [Canadian
- 10 province] that is current or has expired not more than 60 days [two
- 11 years] preceding the date the identification is submitted to the
- 12 county clerk in connection with an application for a license;
- 13 (2) a United States passport that is current or has
- 14 expired not more than 60 days preceding the date the passport is
- 15 submitted to the county clerk in connection with an application for
- 16 a license;
- 17 (3) a current passport issued by a foreign country
- 18 with a valid entry stamp [or a consular document issued by a state
- 19 or national government];
- 20 (4) an unexpired Certificate of United States
- 21 Citizenship, Certificate of Naturalization, United States Citizen
- 22 Identification Card, Permanent Resident Card, Temporary Resident
- 23 Card, Employment Authorization Card, or other document issued by
- 24 the federal Department of Homeland Security or the United States

- 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to an application for a marriage license submitted to a county clerk
- 12 on or after the effective date of this Act. An application for a
- 13 marriage license submitted before the effective date of this Act is
- 14 governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and the
- 15 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
