8 SALES AND USE TAX REVENUES. (a) As soon as practicable after the

9 Legislative Budget Board is notified that the comptroller has

10 reported a month-to-month decline in revenues from state sales and

11 use taxes imposed under Chapter 151, Tax Code, for three

12 consecutive months, the board shall meet to consider whether it is

13 prudent to direct state agencies to reduce expenditures or to take

14 other action to reduce state spending in response to declining

15 state sales and use tax revenues.

16 (b) The comptroller shall send to the director of the

17 Legislative Budget Board, by e-mail or other means as requested by

18 the director, a monthly report showing whether total state sales

19 and use tax revenues for the most recent month for which the

20 <u>information is available are less than the total state sales and use</u>

21 tax revenues for the preceding month.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
