- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 351, Local Government
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 351.045 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 351.045. NOTICE TO SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION.
- 9 (a) The sheriff of a county shall notify the United States Social
- 10 <u>Security Administration of the release or discharge of a prisoner</u>
- 11 who, immediately before the prisoner's confinement in the county
- 12 jail, was receiving:
- 13 (1) Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits under
- 14 42 U.S.C. Section 1381 et seq.; or
- 15 (2) Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)
- 16 benefits under 42 U.S.C. Section 401 et seq.
- 17 (b) The sheriff shall provide the notice described by
- 18 <u>Subsection (a) to the United States Social Security Administration</u>
- 19 by mail and electronically immediately on the prisoner's release or
- 20 discharge from custody. The sheriff shall provide a copy of the
- 21 notice to the prisoner at the time of the prisoner's release or

- 23 <u>(c) The county or sheriff, or an employee of the county or</u>

- 2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to the
- 3 release or discharge of a prisoner from a county jail that occurs on
- 4 or after the effective date of this Act, regardless of the date the
- 5 prisoner was initially confined in the county jail.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- $7\,$  a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
