Section 89.022, Natural Resources Code, 6 is 7 amended by adding Subsections (d), (e), (f), and (g) to read as follows: 8 9 (d) Before the commission issues an order refusing to renew an operator's organization report under Subsection (c), an 10 authorized commission employee or a person designated by the 11 12 commission for that purpose must determine whether the operator has failed to comply with the requirements of this subchapter. If the 13 14 authorized commission employee or designated person determines that the organization report does not qualify for renewal on that 15 16 ground, the authorized commission employee or designated person 17 must: 18 (1) notify the operator of the determination; 19 (2) provide the operator with a written statement of the reasons the organization report does not qualify for renewal; 20 and 21 (3) notify the operator that the operator has 90 days 22 23 to comply with the requirements of this subchapter. 24 (e) The authorized commission employee or designated person

3 (f) After the expiration of the period specified by Subsection (d)(3) as extended under Subsection (e), if applicable, 4 5 the authorized commission employee or designated person shall determine whether the organization report qualifies for renewal and 6 notify the operator of the determination. If the authorized 7 8 commission employee or designated person determines that the organization report does not qualify for renewal because the 9 operator has continued to fail to comply with the requirements of 10 this subchapter, the operator, not later than the 30th day after the 11 12 date of the determination, may request a hearing regarding the 13 determination.

14 (g) If the commission determines following the hearing that 15 the operator has failed to comply with the requirements of this 16 subchapter or the operator fails to file a timely request for a 17 hearing, the commission by order shall refuse to renew the 18 organization report. The organization report remains in effect 19 until the commission's order becomes final.

SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to the renewal of an organization report on or after the effective date of this Act. The renewal of an organization report before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
