- 1 Sec. 1509.201. EXECUTION OF CONTRACTS. A municipality may 2 contract with the state, another municipality, county, or other political subdivision of the state, the federal government or any 3 agency or instrumentality thereof, an individual, private 4 corporation, or other private entity, or a nonprofit corporation, 5 6 including a nonprofit corporation created by or on behalf of the 7 municipality for the acquisition, construction, improvement, implementation, maintenance and operation of a project authorized 8 under this subchapter. A contract under this subsection may be for 9 a period and include terms on which the parties agree. 10
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
