4	SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter D, Chapter 258,
5	Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:
6	SUBCHAPTER D. [ENTERAL] ADMINISTRATION OF ANESTHESIA
7	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 258, Occupations Code, is
8	amended by adding Section 258.158 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 258.158. PORTABILITY OF DEEP SEDATION ANESTHESIA
10	SERVICES. (a) In this section:
11	(1) "Deep sedation" means a drug-induced depression of
12	consciousness during which a patient cannot be easily aroused but
13	responds purposefully following repeated or painful stimulation.
14	(2) "Portability" means, with respect to anesthesia
15	services, the ability of a dentist who holds a permit under this
16	subchapter to provide anesthesia services in a location other than
17	a facility or satellite facility.
18	(b) To qualify for a permit that grants the portability of
19	deep sedation anesthesia services, a dentist must complete at least
20	24 months of training in the use and administration of deep sedation
21	anesthesia.
22	SECTION 3. (a) Not later than January 1, 2012, the State
23	Board of Dental Examiners shall adopt the rules necessary to

implement the changes in law made by this Act.

(b) Section 258.158, Occupations Code, as added by this Act,
applies only to a permit issued on or after March 1, 2012. A permit
issued before March 1, 2012, is governed by the law in effect when
the permit was issued, and the former law is continued in effect for
that purpose.

6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
