A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the verification of citizenship of an applicant for
- 3 voter registration.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 13.071, Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 13.071. REVIEW OF APPLICATION. (a) The registrar
- 8 shall review each submitted application for registration to
- 9 determine whether it complies with Section 13.002 and indicates
- 10 that the applicant is <u>a United States citizen</u> eligible for
- 11 registration.
- 12 (b) If the application is submitted to the Department of
- 13 Public Safety in person with the proof of citizenship required by
- 14 Section 20.063(e), the [The] registrar shall make the
- 15 determination not later than the seventh day after the date the
- 16 application is submitted to the registrar.
- 17 (c) If the application is submitted in a manner other than
- 18 the manner described by Subsection (b), the registrar shall forward
- 19 the information relating to the applicant to the secretary of state
- 20 for determining citizenship as provided by Section 13.0721.
- 21 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 13, Election Code, is
- 22 amended by adding Section 13.0721 to read as follows:
- Sec. 13.0721. DETERMINATION OF CITIZENSHIP. (a) This
- 24 section does not apply to an application for registration submitted

- 1 to the Department of Public Safety in person with the proof of
 2 citizenship required by Section 20.063(e).
- 3 (b) The secretary of state shall verify with the Department
- 4 of Public Safety the citizenship status of each applicant for voter
- 5 registration whose information is forwarded to the secretary of
- 6 state as provided by Section 13.071(c). If the department verifies
- 7 the applicant's citizenship status, the secretary of state shall
- 8 notify the registrar. If the department does not have information
- 9 regarding the citizenship status of the applicant or has
- 10 information indicating that the applicant is not a citizen, the
- 11 registrar and the applicant shall be notified as provided by
- 12 secretary of state rule.
- 13 (c) An applicant for voter registration who receives notice
- 14 under Subsection (b) must provide proof of citizenship to the
- 15 registrar not later than the 60th day after the date of receipt.
- 16 Except as provided by Subsection (d), this proof must be presented
- 17 in person. The following is acceptable as proof of citizenship
- 18 under this section:
- 19 (1) an unexpired passport issued to the person;
- 20 (2) a certified copy of a birth certificate or other
- 21 document confirming the person's birth that is admissible in a
- 22 court of law and establishes the person's identity, presented with
- 23 a government-issued identification that contains the person's
- 24 photograph; or
- 25 (3) United States citizenship papers issued to the
- 26 person, presented with a government-issued identification that
- 27 contains the person's photograph.

- 1 (d) An applicant may mail a certified copy of a document
- 2 described by Subsection (c)(2) or (3) with a copy of the person's
- 3 government-issued photo identification to the registrar.
- 4 (e) If an applicant does not provide proof of citizenship as
- 5 required, the registrar shall reject the application and notify the
- 6 <u>secretary of state.</u> The secretary of state shall keep a list of
- 7 applicants of which the secretary receives notice under this
- 8 section.
- 9 (f) The secretary of state shall adopt rules and prescribe
- 10 procedures to implement this section.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 13.143(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 (a) Except as provided by Subsection [Subsections] (b) [and
- 14 (e)], if an applicant's registration application is approved, the
- 15 registration becomes effective on the 30th day after the date the
- 16 application is approved [submitted to the registrar] or on the date
- 17 the applicant becomes 18 years of age, whichever is later.
- 18 SECTION 4. Section 20.063, Election Code, is amended by
- 19 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 20 (e) A person who submits a voter registration application to
- 21 the department in person shall at the time of submission present as
- 22 proof of citizenship:
- 23 (1) an unexpired passport issued to the person;
- 24 (2) a certified copy of a birth certificate or other
- 25 document confirming the person's birth that is admissible in a
- 26 court of law and establishes the person's identity; or
- 27 (3) United States citizenship papers issued to the

- 1 person.
- 2 SECTION 5. Sections 13.041 and 13.143(d) and (e), Election
- 3 Code, are repealed.
- 4 SECTION 6. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 5 an application to register to vote submitted on or after the
- 6 effective date of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
