A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to responsibilities of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and Production Area Authorizations. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 27.0513, Water Code, is amended as 5 follows: 6 7 (d) Notwithstanding Sections 5.551, 5.556, 27.011, and 27.018, an application for an authorization submitted after 8 September 1, 2007, is an uncontested matter not subject to a 9 contested case hearing or the hearing requirements of Chapter 2001, 10 Government Code., unless the authorization seeks any of the 11 12 following: 13 (1) an amendment to a restoration table value; (2) the initial establishment of monitoring wells for 14 any area covered by the authorization, including the location, 15 number, depth, spacing, and design of the monitoring wells, unless 16 the executive director uses the recommendation of an independent 17 third-party expert chosen by the commission; or 18 (3) an amendment to the type or amount of bond required 19 for groundwater restoration or by Section 27.073 to assure that 20 21 there are sufficient funds available to the state for groundwater restoration or the plugging of abandoned wells in the area by a 22 23 third-party contractor. 24 (e) The executive director may use an independent

1 third-party expert if:

2 (1) the expert meets the qualifications set by3 commission rules for such experts;

4 (2) the applicant for the authorization agrees to pay5 the costs for the work of the expert; and

6 (3) the applicant for the authorization is not 7 involved in the selection of the expert or the direction of the work 8 of the expert.

9 (f) An application seeking approval under Subsections 10 (d)(1)=(3) is subject to the public notice and contested hearing 11 requirements provided in Section 27.018.

12 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect 13 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members 14 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas 15 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for 16 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
