6	SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 843, Insurance Code, is

- SECTION 2. Chapter 1301, Insurance Code, is amended by

- 18 services are provided within the limits of their knowledge, skills
- 19 and training pursuant to a contract with a preferred provider is not
- 20 <u>subject to the requirements in Chapter 157 of the Occupations Code.</u>
- SECTION 3. Section 1451.106, Subchapter E, Chapter 1451,
- 22 Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 1451.106. SELECTION OF ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSE. An
- 24 insured may select an advanced practice nurse to provide the

- 1 services scheduled in the health insurance policy that are within
- 2 the scope of the nurse's license. An advanced practice registered
- 3 nurse whose services are provided within the limits of their
- 4 knowledge, skills and training is not subject to the requirements
- 5 <u>in Chapter 157 of the Occupations Code.</u>
- 6 SECTION 4. Sections 843.3116 and 1451.2066, Insurance Code,
- 7 as added by this Act, apply only to a contract entered into or
- 8 renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A contract
- 9 entered into or renewed before the effective date of this Act is
- 10 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 11 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
