1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the repeal of requirements and penalties related to the  
1-9 grading of roses.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 5, Agriculture Code, is  
1-12 repealed.

1-13 SECTION 2. Section 12.020(c), Agriculture Code, is amended  
1-14 to read as follows:

1-15 (c) The provisions of law subject to this section and the  
1-16 applicable penalty amounts are as follows:

1-32 SECTION 3. The repeal by this Act of Chapter 121,  
1-33 Agriculture Code, does not apply to an offense committed under that  
1-34 chapter before the effective date of the repeal. An offense  
1-35 committed before the effective date of the repeal is governed by  
1-36 that chapter as it existed on the date the offense was committed,  
1-37 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For  
1-38 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the  
1-39 effective date of the repeal if any element of the offense occurred  
1-40 before that date.

1-41 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-42 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-44 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-45 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
