4	SECTION 1. Section 251.003, Occupations Code, is amended by

 13 or another description, including the use of the terms "denturist"
 14 or "denturism," that, directly or indirectly, represents that the
 15 person is able to:
- 16 (A) diagnose, treat, or remove stains or 17 concretions from human teeth; or
- (B) provide surgical and adjunctive treatment for a disease, pain, injury, deficiency, deformity, or physical condition of the human teeth, oral cavity, alveolar process, gums, jaws, or directly related and adjacent masticatory structures;
- 22 (2) performs or offers to perform by any means the:
- 23 (A) cleaning of human teeth;
- 24 (B) removal of stains, concretions, or deposits

- 15 (4) owns, maintains, or operates an office or place of

- 1 (10) represents that the person is a denturist or uses
- 2 another title that is intended to convey to the public that the
- 3 services offered by the person are included within the practice of

- 5 (11) provides or performs, or offers to provide or
- 6 perform, a teeth whitening treatment or a product or service
- 7 related to a teeth whitening treatment.
- 8 <u>(d) In this subtitle, "teeth whitening treatment" means a</u>
- 9 chemical or other material, tool, product, service, or procedure
- 10 intended to whiten human teeth. The term does not include a product
- 11 sold over the counter to an ultimate consumer.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
