A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the provision of certain health care services to 3 certain state employees by or at certain university facilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1551.226 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1551.226. SERVICES BY CERTAIN UNIVERSITY FACILITIES.
- 8 The board of trustees shall negotiate with hospitals and clinics
- 9 operated by a medical and dental unit, as defined by Section 61.003,
- 10 Education Code, to provide health care services to participants in
- 11 the manner described by Section 51.976, Education Code.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 1601, Insurance Code, is
- 13 amended by adding Section 1601.156 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 1601.156. SERVICES BY CERTAIN UNIVERSITY FACILITIES.
- 15 A system shall negotiate with hospitals and clinics operated by a
- 16 medical and dental unit, as defined by Section 61.003, Education
- 17 Code, to provide health care services to individuals covered by a
- 18 health benefit plan provided under this chapter in the manner
- 19 <u>described by Section 51.976</u>, Education Code.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 21 amended by adding Section 51.976 to read as follows:
- 22 <u>Sec. 51.976. HEALTH CARE SERVICES FOR CERTAIN STATE</u>
- 23 EMPLOYEES. A hospital or clinic operated by a medical and dental
- 24 unit, as defined by Section 61.003, shall provide health care

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- 1 services within the scope of the services otherwise provided by the
- 2 hospital or clinic, at a rate that is discounted at least 50 percent
- 3 <u>to:</u>
- 4 (1) participants in the group benefits program under
- 5 Chapter 1551, Insurance Code; or
- 6 (2) an individual covered by a health benefit plan
- 7 provided under Chapter 1601, Insurance Code.
- 8 SECTION 4. The Employees Retirement System of Texas, the
- 9 governing boards of The University of Texas System and The Texas A&M
- 10 University System, and medical and dental units shall enter into
- 11 contracts or other agreements necessary for the implementation of
- 12 Sections 1551.226 and 1601.156, Insurance Code, as added by this
- 13 Act, and Section 51.976, Education Code, as added by this Act,
- 14 during the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2011, with
- 15 coverage under those sections of the Insurance Code and Education
- 16 Code beginning on September 1, 2012.
- 17 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
