5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 468.004, Government Code, is amended to
7	read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 468. STATE DEMOGRAPHER
9	Sec. 468.004 POWERS AND DUTIES
10	The state demographer shall:
11	(1) disseminate demographic and related socioeconomic
12	data to the public, with emphasis on data that may be useful to
13	<pre>public policymakers;</pre>
14	(2) provide annual population estimates for all
15	counties and municipalities in the state;
16	(3) provide biennial population projections for the
17	state and all counties of the state;
18	(4) adhere to current standards of practice when
19	determining which racial/ethnic groups to include in estimates and
20	<pre>projections;</pre>
21	(5) provide information by request which justifies the
22	omission of any particular racial/ethnic group from estimates and
23	projections, including limitations of data and methodology;

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- 1 relating to the impact that demographic and socioeconomic changes

- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
