- 5 SECTION 1. Section 387.005(a), Health and Safety Code, is

- 7 (a) Grants awarded under this chapter shall be directed
- 8 toward a balanced mix of:
- 9 (1) retrofit and add-on technologies and other
- 10 advanced technologies, including traffic-control signalization
- 11 <u>technologies and programs</u>, that reduce emissions from the existing
- 12 stock of engines and vehicles targeted by the Texas emissions
- 13 reduction plan, provided that the technologies do not significantly
- 14 reduce the fuel economy of those engines and vehicles;
- 15 (2) advanced technologies for new engines and vehicles
- 16 that produce very-low or zero emissions of oxides of nitrogen,
- 17 including stationary and mobile fuel cells;
- 18 (3) advanced technologies for reducing oxides of
- 19 nitrogen and other emissions from stationary sources; and
- 20 (4) field validation of innovative technologies that:
- 21 (A) reduce emissions of oxides of nitrogen and
- 22 other emissions; and
- 23 (B) require demonstration of viability for full
- 24 commercial acceptance.
