- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2301.712(a), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The board shall determine the amount of the [The] filing
- 8 fee for a contested case or a protest that involves a hearing
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 643.001, Transportation Code, is amended
- 10 by amending Subdivision (1) and adding Subdivision (1-a) to read as
- 11 follows:

- 12 (1) "Board" means the board of the Texas Department of
- 13 Motor Vehicles.
- 14 (1-a) "Department" means the Texas Department of Motor
- 15 Vehicles.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 1001, Transportation Code,
- 17 is amended by adding Section 1001.0421 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1001.0421. REVENUE FORECAST. The board shall prepare
- 19 <u>a forecast containing a detailed report of estimated revenue for</u>
- 20 the state highway fund on a biennial basis.
- 21 SECTION 4. Chapter 1002, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 22 adding Sections 1002.004 and 1002.005 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1002.004. PUBLICATION OF FEES. The board shall
- 24 publish on the department's Internet website a schedule of all fees

- 1 set by the board.
- Sec. 1002.005. AMOUNT OF FEES. Notwithstanding any other
- 3 law, if the board has authority to collect or administer a fee in
- 4 support of a program or regulatory function, the board may by rule
- 5 set the fee in an amount determined by the board if:
- 6 (1) the board submits the proposed fee to the
- 7 Legislative Budget Board for review; and
- 8 <u>(2)</u> the Legislative Budget Board determines the
- 9 proposed fee will recover all direct and indirect costs of
- 10 administering the program or regulatory function the fee is
- 11 <u>intended to support.</u>
- 12 SECTION 5. The fees in effect on the effective date of this
- 13 Act continue in effect until they are modified by the Texas
- 14 Department of Motor Vehicles.
- 15 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
