4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 247.002(1), Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(1) "Assisted living facility" means an establishment
8	that:
9	(A) furnishes, in one or more facilities, food
10	and shelter to four or more persons who are unrelated to the
11	proprietor of the establishment;
12	(B) provides:
13	(i) personal care services; or
14	(ii) administration of medication by a
15	person licensed or otherwise authorized in this state to administer
16	the medication; [and]
17	(C) may provide assistance with or supervision of
18	the administration of medication; and
19	(D) may provide skilled nursing services for a
20	limited duration or to facilitate the provision of hospice
21	services.
22	SECTION 2. Section 247.067(b), Health and Safety Code, is
23	amended to read as follows:
24	(b) Unless otherwise prohibited by law, a $[A]$ health care

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professional may be employed by an assisted living facility to 1 provide at the facility to the facility's residents services that 2 are authorized by this chapter and within the professional's scope 3 4 of practice [to a resident of an assisted living facility at the This subsection does not authorize a facility to 5 facility]. provide ongoing services comparable to the services available in an 6 institution licensed under Chapter 242. A health care professional 7 providing services under this subsection shall maintain medical 8 records of those services in accordance with the licensing, 9 certification, or other regulatory standards applicable to the 10 health care professional under law. 11

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
